Resolution No. 7/2000

INTERNATIONAL COMMERCIAL ARBITRATION

The 69th Conference of the International Law Association, held in London, United Kingdom, 25-29 July 2000:

HAVING CONSIDERED the Report on Public Policy as a Bar to the Enforcement of Arbitral Awards presented at this Conference;

RECOGNISING the importance of finality in arbitration proceedings but also the role of public policy in upholding various fundamental principles and rules;

REQUESTS the Committee to continue its study of public policy with a view to drafting Recommendations to State Courts on Public Policy as a Bar to the Enforcement of Arbitral Awards, having regard to the comments made at this Conference, and presenting a final report at the 70th Conference in New Delhi in 2002;

REQUESTS the Committee to commence a study of *res judicata*, *lis pendens* and related issues in international arbitration and to present an interim report at the New Delhi Conference.
