Resolution No. 20/2000

REFUGEE PROCEDURES

The 69th Conference of the International Law Association, held in London, United Kingdom, 25-29 July 2000:

NOTING the Third Interim Report on Temporary Protection of the Committee on Refugee Procedures;

CONGRATULATING the Rapporteur responsible on his very valuable work;

WELCOMING the progress made by the Committee on Refugee Procedures;

REAFFIRMING the need to re-evaluate the concept and practice of temporary protection with a view to strengthening the protection of persons fleeing the dangers of armed conflict and generalised violence or of widespread and systematic human rights violations;

FURTHER REAFFIRMING the need to re-evaluate the role, scope and potential of refugee procedures with a view to protecting those fleeing persecution, in order to develop minimum standards to be observed in all national jurisdictions;

REQUESTS the Committee to submit its final report to the 70th Conference of the Association to be held in New Delhi in 2002.
