

RESOLUTION 8/2018

STUDY GROUP ON BUSINESS AND HUMAN RIGHTS

The 78th Conference of the International Law Association, held in Sydney, Australia, 19–24 August 2018:

ACKNOWLEDGING the continuing significance of the United Nations Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights to the development of international and domestic law and policy, and also the practices of States, business enterprises and other actors;

DESIRING to contribute to the successful implementation of the UN Guiding Principles and to the progressive development of international law;

TAKES NOTE of the issues of international law identified by the Study Group which may pose an obstacle to the implementation of the UN Guiding Principles;

TAKES NOTE FURTHER of the suggestion of the Study Group that the Executive Council of the ILA establish a Committee on Business and Human Rights;

COMMENDS the Final Report of the Study Group;

RECOMMENDS to the Executive Council that the Study Group, having completed its mandate, be dissolved.
